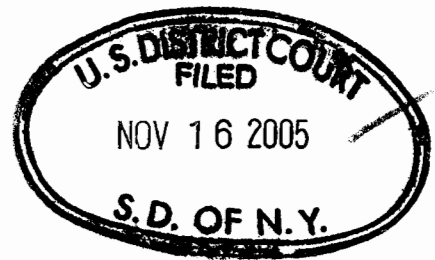

WHEREAS on March 18, 2005, the Court approved a Stipulation and Order (the "March 2005 Order") to govern the conduct of the 2006 International Union delegate and officer election (the "2006 IBT Election"); and

WHEREAS Paragraph Four of the March 2005 Order provides that the United States of America and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters ("IBT") (collectively, the "Parties") would jointly agree upon election rules to govern the 2006 IBT Election following comments by IBT members and any interested parties, and would submit the agreed-upon rules to the Court for its consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS the Parties have now agreed upon rules to govern the 2006 IBT Election (the "Proposed 2006 Election Rules"); and

WHEREAS the Parties have submitted the Proposed 2006 Election Rules to this Court for its consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS the Court has reviewed the Proposed 2006 Election Rules and finds that approval and enforcement of those Rules will further the objectives of the Consent Decree;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Proposed 2006 Election Rules, a copy of which is annexed hereto, are approved *with the exception of Article VII, Section 6* and shall govern the 2006 IBT Election unless modified in accordance with the March 2005 Order.
