**ANNOUNCEMENT OF SEASONAL LOCAL UNIONS SCHEDULED TO CONDUCT
DELEGATE NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS IN THE SUMMER OF 2010 AND
NOTIFICATION OF NUMBER OF DELEGATES TO BE ELECTED**

ELECTION PLANS FOR SEASONAL LOCALS DUE ON JUNE 1, 2010

Article II, Sec. 3(a)(2) of the proposed *Rules for the 2010-2011 IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election* (the “2010 Rules”) requires the Election Supervisor to determine the delegate and alternate delegate nomination and election schedule for IBT seasonal locals based on the time of year when seasonal employment is likely to be at a peak based on data provided by the IBT and, considering the schedule for the election process, when it would be most appropriate to conduct the election. The *2011 Rules* define “seasonal Local Union” as a Local Union in which 10% or more of the membership is employed by a seasonal food industry employer.

The Election Supervisor has provisionally determined that the local unions listed below are seasonal Local Unions required to nominate and elect delegates and alternate delegate(s) to the IBT International Union convention during the Summer of 2010. The number of delegates for each seasonal local to elect, as calculated based on IBT data is also stated below. Delegate strength of each local union may change over time, and the final calculation of local union delegate strength for the convention will be made in the Spring of 2011.

A provisionally designated seasonal local may request the Election Supervisor to review the designation, and submit facts to support a request that the local be allowed to conduct its nomination and election of delegates and alternate delegate(s) either in the fall of 2010 or in 2011.

Local Union Plans for delegate and alternate delegate elections conducted in the Summer of 2010 are due to the Election Office by June 1, 2010. The on-line tool for completing and submitting local union election plans will be available on Monday, May 11, 2010. An Election Office representative will contact each seasonal Local Union and explain the use of this new tool.
