The procedure for accreditation is stated in Article X of the *Rules for the 2010-2011 IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election ("2011 Rules")* and in the July 14, 2010 Advisory on Accreditation of Candidates and Publication of Campaign Literature in *The Teamster*. On June 1, 2010, the Election Supervisor announced the following accredited candidate petition signature requirements:

The eligible members named above delivered petitions bearing 99,242 complete signatures for James P. Hoffa, Ken Hall, Randy Cammack, Albert Mixon, Frederick Potter, Freddie Simpson, and George Tedeschi; 25,169 complete signatures for Brian Buhle, John Coli, and Gordon Sweeton; 30,610 complete signatures for William Hamilton, Dan Kane, Sr., George Miranda, and John F. Murphy; 9,700 complete signatures for Tyson Johnson and Ken Wood; 21,876 complete signatures for Rome Aloise and Rick Middleton; and 12,087 complete signatures for Robert Bouvier, Stan Hennessy, and Craig McInnes.

The Office of the Election Supervisor has reviewed the submitted petition signatures using a statistical sampling method, and has determined that the petitions contain more than the minimum number of valid signatures to accredit each eligible member named above.


