Anyone may link to or promote www.ibtvote.org as a source for the debate.

Any IBT member can get a DVD recording and/or a transcript of the debate, free of charge. The identity of any member that requests a DVD or transcript from OES is confidential.

The Local Secretary-Treasurer must make the DVD available upon request to any member, or group of members, for viewing or copying.
