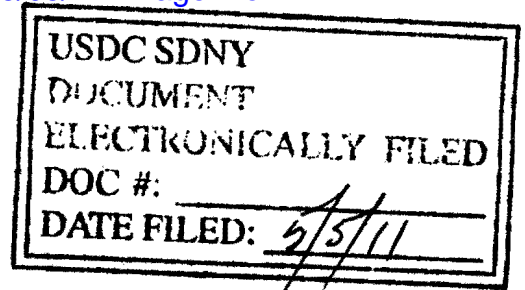

ORDER

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2009, the Court approved a Stipulation and Order (the "November 2009 Order") to govern the conduct of the 2011 International Union delegate and officer election (the "2011 IBT Election");

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2010, the Court approved election rules to govern the 2011 IBT Election (the "2011 Election Rules");

WHEREAS, Paragraph four of the November 2009 Order and the 2011 Election Rules both provide that the Government and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters ("IBT") (collectively, the "Parties") would jointly agree upon supplemental election rules to govern the schedule and procedures for the nomination of candidates for International offices and the secret ballot nomination vote;

WHEREAS, Paragraph four of the November 2009 Order further provides that the Parties would submit the agreed-upon supplemental election rules to the Court for its consideration and approval;

WHEREAS, the Parties have now agreed upon supplemental rules to govern the schedule


and procedures for the nomination of candidates and the secret ballot nomination vote for the 2011 IBT Election (the "Proposed 2011 Supplemental Election Rules");

WHEREAS, the Parties have submitted the Proposed 2011 Supplemental Election Rules to the Court for its consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Court has reviewed the Proposed 2011 Supplemental Election Rules and finds that approval and enforcement of those Rules will further the objectives of the Consent Decree;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Proposed 2011 Supplemental Election Rules, a copy of which is annexed hereto, are approved and shall govern the schedule and procedures for the nomination of candidates and the secret ballot nomination vote with respect to the 2011 Election unless modified in accordance with the November 2009 Order.
