Dear Chief Judge Preska:

I write to inform the Court that Teamsters for a Democratic Union ("TDU") and the Association for Union Democracy ("AUD") have notified the Government that they may file objections to the joint application, by the Government and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters ("IBT"), for approval of the 2011 IBT Election Rules. Pursuant to the instruction of Your Honor's chambers, the Government, IBT, Election Supervisor, TDU, and AUD have agreed upon a schedule for objections to the joint application and any responses. The Government respectfully requests that the Court set the following schedule, to which all such parties have agreed - that any objections from TDU, AUD, or any other objecting party be filed no later than May 14, 2010; that any response from the Government, IBT, or Election Supervisor be filed no later than May 25, 2010; and that any replies be filed no later than June 1, 2010.

We thank the Court for its consideration of this matter and respectfully request that this letter be docketed with the Clerk of the Court and made a part of the record in this case.
