

ELECTION APPEALS MASTER

This matter is an appeal from the Election Administrator's decision 2001 EAD 462 issued September 20, 2001. The appeal hearing was requested by James L. Hicks, Jr., on behalf of the Hoffa Campaign.

A hearing was held before me on September 27, 2001. The following persons were heard by way of teleconference: Jeffrey J. Ellison, Esq., for the Election Administrator's Office; James L. Hicks, Jr., Esq. on behalf of the Hoffa Campaign; Barbara Harvey, Esq. on behalf of the Teamsters for a Democratic Union.

I have examined a flyer circulated by the Hoffa Slate Campaign without any indication of its political origin or sponsorship that has been found by the Election Administrator to have traded on the prestige of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, and therefore to have violated the Election Rules.

Precedent and logic support this finding, and accordingly, the Election Administrator's decision in this matter is affirmed.
