This matter was resolved in 01 Elec. App. 100 (KC) by order dated October 19, 2001.

I have subsequently received an application from the Election Administrator dated October 23, 2001 seeking reconsideration of the order. I received three letters dated September 21, 22 and 24, 2001 from Barbara Harvey, Esq., counsel to the protester, in which she also seeks reconsideration of the order.
