
ORDER

The motion of the Election Supervisor to dismiss this appeal is granted.

Article XIII, Section 2(i) of the *Rules* requires that the person aggrieved by the determination of the protest make his appeal in writing and deliver it to the Election Appeals Master, the Election Supervisor and to all other parties to the dispute. To date, appellant has not delivered his appeal to the Election Supervisor; the Election Supervisor therefore cannot respond to the appeal or otherwise prepare for the hearing in this matter scheduled for Tuesday, March 7, 2006, at 10:30 a.m.

The failure to deliver the appeal as required by the *Rules* constitutes a failure to appeal timely. Accordingly, the original protest decision is deemed final and binding, pursuant to Article XIII, Section 2(j) of the *Rules*.
