Gentlemen:

A protest was filed with the Election Officer pursuant to Article XI of the Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1, 1991 ("Election Rules"). A copy of the protest is enclosed. In his protest Ernest Schneider, a certified delegate to the 1991 IBT International Convention from Local Union 490, alleges that the Local Union violated the Election Rules as a result of its failure to make arrangements for the payment of its delegates' hotel accommodations during their attendance at the International Convention.

On June 23, 1991, the Election Officer was advised that Mr. Sawyer had provided funds for the payment of hotel accommodations for all the delegates from Local 490 by check delivered to one of the delegates. Accordingly, the Election Officer determines this protest is RESOLVED.

If any interested party is not satisfied with this determination, they may request a hearing before the Independent Administrator within twenty-four (24) hours of their receipt of this letter. The parties are reminded that, absent extraordinary circumstances, no party may rely upon evidence that was not presented to the Office of the Election Officer in any such appeal. Requests for a hearing shall be made in writing, and shall be filed with The Office of the Independent Administrator, IBT, c/o Walt Disney World Dolphin Hotel, Suite 1033, 1500 EPCOT Resort
