Gentlemen:

A protest has been filed with the Election Officer pursuant to Article XI of the Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1, 1990 ("Election Rules"). A copy of the protest is enclosed. In his protest Denis Taylor, a member of Local Union 355, alleges that the Election Rules were violated because John V. Sullivan, a retired member of Local Union 355, was appointed to serve on the Rules Committee. The Election Officer's investi-gation revealed the following:

Under the IBT Constitution the General President is authorized to appoint members to the Rules Committee. See Article III, Section 8 of the IBT International Constitution. Other than members of the Credentials Committee, Committee members need not be Convention delegates. The Election Officer has no jurisdiction over the appointment of members of the IBT to serve on the IBT International Convention Rules Committee. Mr. Sullivan is not a delegate to the 1991 Convention and will not participate in the nomination process or the election of International Union Trustees at the Convention. Mr. Taylor has failed to state a claim within the jurisdiction of the Election Officer.

For the foregoing reasons, the instant protest is DENIED.

If any interested party is not satisfied with this determination, they may request a hearing before the Independent Administrator within twenty-four (24) hours of their receipt of this letter. The parties are reminded that, absent extraordinary circumstances, no party may rely upon evidence that was not presented to the Office of the Election Officer in any such appeal. A copy of the protest must accompany the request for a hearing.


