**Re: Election Office Case No. P-128-LU385-SEC**

Gentlemen:

A pre-election protest was filed pursuant to the *Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election*, revised August 1, 1990 ("Rules"). The protest concerns a prior protest filed by Danny Peterson, P-092-LU385-SEC, and alleges that Mr. Peterson failed to provide a copy of such protest to the Local Union as required under the *Rules*. The Election Officer notes that Local 385 in fact received a copy of Mr. Peterson's protest from the Election Officer and thus was not harmed even if, as alleged, Mr. Peterson failed to serve a copy of his protest on the Local.


Mr. Peterson, with the approval of the Election Officer withdrew his protest, P-092-LU385-SEC rendering moot the instant protest. Thus the Election Officer dismisses the instant protest as moot.

If any person is not satisfied with this determination, he may request a hearing before the Administrator within twenty-four (24) hours of his receipt of this letter. Such request shall be made in writing and shall be served on Administrator Frederick B. Lacey at LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae, One Gateway Center, Newark, N.J. 07102-5311, Facsimile (201) 622-6693. Copies of the request for hearing must be served on the parties listed above as well as upon

the Election Officer, IBT, 25 Louisiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001, Facsimile (202) 624-8792. A copy of the protest must accompany the request for a hearing. The parties are reminded that absent extraordinary circumstances, no party may rely upon evidence that was not presented to the Office of the Election Officer in any such appeal.
