## Gentlemen

A pre-election protest was timely filed pursuant to Article XI, Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1, 1990 ("Rules"). In this protest, Mr John Bryan alleges that he has been re-assigned from local work to over the road work by his employer, Chemical Leaman Tank Lines, because he is a candidate for delegate to the 1991 IBT International Convention

Subsequent to the filing of the protest, Mr Bryan informed the Election Office that he now requests to withdraw the protest. The protest has been investigated by the Election Officer's Representative. After considering the evidence presented during the investigation, the Election Officer concludes that approval of the withdrawal request is consistent with effectuating the purposes of the Rules.

Accordingly, the withdrawal is approved
