Gentlemen

The above referenced pre-election protest was timely filed pursuant to Article XI of the Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1 1990 (Rules) In his protest Mr Don Stone contends that Heublein, Inc is violating the Rules because it has prohibited him from campaigning at its Allen Park, Michigan location contrary to past practice Mr Stone is not an employee of Heublein

Subsequent to the filing of the protest the Election Officer commenced discussions with the employer concerning its access policy. The employer has agreed with the Election Officer that IBT members can campaign on company property inside the fenced in compound where Heublein is located. IBT members will be specifically permitted to distribute literature speak with employees and otherwise campaign at the main employee entrance near the picnic table. Those members who are engaged in such campaign activity shall report to the security guard upon entering the Heublein premises and obtain a badge prior to commencing campaign activities. The Election Officer concludes that agreement by Heublein as described by the foregoing will insure the campaign access rights of IBT members and resolves the instant protest.

¹The Election Officer notes that in his protest Mr Stone states that he actively campaigned at Heublein from September 1989 until January 24 1991 The election in this Local was a mail ballot the ballots were counted on January 31, 1991 Thus it appears that the short amount of time that has elapsed between Heublein's prohibition

Based on the foregoing, this protest is RESOLVED.

If any interested party is not satisfied with this determination, they may request a hearing before the Independent Administrator within twenty-four (24) hours of their receipt of this letter. The parties are reminded that, absent extraordinary circumstances, no party may rely upon evidence that was not presented to the Office of the Election Officer in any such appeal. Requests for a hearing shall be made in writing, and shall be served on Independent Administrator Frederick B. Lacey at LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae, One Gateway Center, Newark, New Jersey 07102-5311, Facsimile (201) 622-6693. Copies of the request for hearing must be served on the parties listed above, as well as upon the Election Officer, IBT, 25 Louisiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D. C 20001, Facsimile (202) 624-8792. A copy of the protest must accompany the request for a hearing.
