This will acknowledge receipt of the above-referenced pre-election protest filed under Article XI, Section 1 of the *Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election*, revised August 1, 1990 ("*Rules*") In your protest you contend that at the nominations meeting for Local 375, a member was present who wished to be a second seconder to your nomination, but was not recognized by the Chair at that meeting

My investigation discloses that you were properly nominated and seconded at the nominations meeting for Local 375 Your nomination was not challenged or protested by any member or officer of the Local Under the *Rules*, to be nominated a member need only one nominator and one seconder You were properly nominated by a member and your nomination was properly seconded by a second member of the Local It was unnecessary for you to have two members both second your nomination

Under the circumstances of this case -- and given that no one has protested or challenged your nomination -- I see no need to further investigate or issue a decision on your protest Accordingly, I consider the matter closed
