## Re. Election Office Case No. P-619-LU769-SEC

## Gentlemen

A pre-election protest was filed pursuant to Article XI, Section 1 of the *Rules for* the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1, 1990 ("Rules"), by Jack Barmon, a member of Local 769, on behalf of Dennis Hatler, a member of Local 79 and an employee of United Parcel Service ("UPS"), an employer of members of Local 79 The protest alleges that Mr Hatler's employer threatened him with termination based upon Mr Hatler's campaign activities

Complainant contends that Dennis Hatler received a note from his supervisor, which was placed in his personnel file, that stated in pertinent part as follows " if I ever find another TDU paper in or around UPS property I will fire you " The Election Officer has contacted the Mr Hatler's employer, UPS, concerning this protest The employer has agreed to remove the note from Mr Hatler's personnel file The removal of the note is consistent with the position of the Election Officer concerning rights of members to campaign on employer premises pursuant to Article VIII, Section 10 of the *Rules* 

Based on the foregoing agreement, the Election Officer has determined that this protest is **RESOLVED**
