**SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION REGARDING EXPENSES AT THE 31st INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS**

On March 19, 2026, I published an Advisory Regarding Payment of Expenses for Convention Delegates and Alternate Delegates to the 31th International Convention of the IBT (the “Advisory”). Since that date, additional information concerning convention-related expenses has been provided to my office by the IBT. This supplement is provided to update delegates, alternate delegates and the local unions that they represent.

**A. Per Diem Personal Expense Allowance levels**

The Advisory required reimbursement of delegates and alternate delegates for personal expenses with a daily sum not to be less than \$130.00 per diem or more than \$195.00 per diem. These levels are not set by the Election Supervisor but were provided to my office by the General Secretary-Treasurer of the IBT. My office is not authorized to modify the minimum or maximum reimbursement standards set by the union, only to ensure that they are uniformly applied to the members.

**B. Hotel Accommodations**

The Advisory required Local Unions to pay for hotel accommodations for their delegates (and alternates, if applicable), exclusive of any incidental charges such as telephone, food, beverages, or entertainment. The cost of the accommodation was described as \$175.00 per night, plus taxes. However, Caesar’s Palace charges an additional, “Resort Fee” of \$45.95 per night and this additional charge must also be paid by the Local Union.

Likewise, in describing the reimbursement for delegates and alternate delegates who have chosen to make their own arrangements or stay at a hotel other than Caesar’s Palace, Local Unions’ maximum obligation to reimburse will be the sum of the \$175.00 daily hotel rate, plus the Resort Fee and any applicable taxes.

Finally, the IBT has been advised that rooms at Caesar’s Palace are extremely limited on the night of June 18, 2026 and the only rooms available in the hotel for that night will be charged at the rate of \$339.00 (plus the Resort Fee and applicable taxes.)
